## **CONSENT RESOLUTION SUMMARY**

This summary is published under section 54(3) of the Teachers Act to protect the identity of a student who was harmed, abused or exploited by the teacher.

- 1. The Teacher holds a Professional Certificate of Qualification.
- 2. At all material times, the Teacher was employed as a high school teacher at a District school in British Columbia (the "School").
- 3. In June 2017, the District made a report to the Commissioner regarding the Teacher, under section 16 of the *School Act*.
- 4. In 2017, the Teacher failed to immediately report an incident of a student's suspected self-harming to District staff or the student's parents even though the Teacher was aware that the student had been previously hospitalized for suicidal thoughts.
- 5. In July 2017, the Teacher resigned from the District.
- 6. On \_\_\_\_\_\_, the Teacher entered into a consent resolution agreement with the Commissioner in which the Teacher agreed that his conduct described in paragraph 4 above constitutes professional misconduct and is contrary to Standard #1 of the *Standards for the Education, Competence and Professional Conduct of Educators in British Columbia*, Fourth Edition, January 2012.
- 7. The Teacher further agreed to a reprimand under sections 53 and 64(a) of the *Teachers Act*.
