

DISCIPLINE CASE SUMMARY

a. A Member (93-B)

- b. Conduct Unbecoming a Member, Professional Misconduct.
- **c.** The hearing was held on three days in October and November of 1993 and the recommendations were presented to the Council in December, 1993.
- **d.** This case involved a teacher who was accused of two charges of sexually assaulting a young female employee in 1991 and one charge of sexually assaulting a teenage female student in 1989. The assaults involved inappropriate sexual comments, and the grabbing of breasts and the pinching of bottoms. The assault of the young female employee reflects on the teaching profession because it involved a breach of trust and an abuse of a power situation.
- **e.** The College of Teachers found him guilty of conduct unbecoming a member for two charges of sexual assault of the female employee and found him guilty of professional misconduct for the sexual assault of the young female student. The College determined that his certificate of qualification should be cancelled. He had previously resigned from his membership in the College. He is not being identified to protect the identity of his family.
