DISCIPLINE CASE SUMMARY

- a. Victor Murray Inman (DOB: 1955.12.13)

- b. Conduct Unbecoming a Member.
- c. The hearing was held November 4, 1994 at the offices of the B.C. College of Teachers. The report and recommendations of the hearing panel were presented to the Council on January 20, 1995.
- d. The citation alleged that Victor Murray Inman committed conduct unbecoming a member in that he was found guilty of one count of sexual assault against a male child.
- e. On or about March 21, 1994, Victor Murray Inman pleaded guilty in the Provincial Court of BC to one count of sexual assault occurring between April 30, 1988 and October 31 1991. The assaults were on one male family friend at various locations in BC. For these offences Mr. Inman was sentenced to two years less a day. His actions constituted a serious breach of trust and a betrayal of both the profession and the public. Consequently, the hearing panel determined that Mr. Inman was guilty of conduct unbecoming a member and recommended that his certificate of qualification be cancelled and that his membership in the B.C. College of Teachers be terminated.
- f. The College cancelled Mr. Inman's certificate of qualification and terminated his membership.
