DISCIPLINE CASE SUMMARY

a. A Member (92-F)

b. Professional Misconduct.

c. The report and recommendations of the hearing panel were presented to Council on March 26, 1992.

d. The citation alleged that a member committed professional misconduct by engaging in an inappropriate and sexual relationship with a female student.

The relationship started when the student was fifteen years old and was being taught by the member. It continued for a period of five years from 1985 until 1990. The member resigned from his teaching position as a result of a board investigation into the relationship.

e. The College of Teachers found the member guilty of professional misconduct and determined that his membership in the College of Teachers be terminated and his certificate of qualification be cancelled.
