DISCIPLINE CASE SUMMARY

a. A Member (99-A)

b. Professional Misconduct.

c. The hearing was held April 19, 1999 in the boardroom of the College. The report and recommendations of the hearing panel were presented to Council on May 20, 1999.

d. The member was found guilty of Section 149(1) of the Criminal Code of Canada on December 14, 1995. The member admitted that while employed as a teacher, he engaged in inappropriate and improper sexual activity with a female student between 1977 and 1979. The member accepted responsibility for the relationship.

e. The panel considered this relationship constituted a serious breach of the trust placed in members of the profession and found the member guilty of professional misconduct.

f. The panel recommended that the member's certificate of qualification be cancelled and his membership terminated. The member consented to this recommendation.
